Hebrews 11:1 defines faith this way: **“Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things (we) hope for, being the proof of things (we) do not see and the conviction of their reality (faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses).”** Mark 11:22 says, **“Have faith in God”**, or as the Greek text says, “Have the God-kind of faith.” This lesson will show you how to actually have the God-kind of faith; how to develop it and how to use it. God wants us to do much more than simply believe that He is. Heb. 11:6 says, **“Without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him.”** Learn to believe God and to put your total, absolute trust in Him!
